MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE HUNGARIAN ASSOCIATION FOR COACHING PSYCHOLOGY and ISCP

This memorandum of understanding acknowledges a desire on the part of the Hungarian Association for Coaching Psychology (HACP) and the International Society for Coaching Psychology (ISCP) to communicate and work together in support of the development of the Coaching Psychology profession internationally. It recognises that the organisations share interests and that they seek to establish ways in which the organisations can co-operate.

The link between HACP and ISCP is highly valued because the organisations:

- Share a common purpose and hold the same values;
- Operate in different yet complementary contexts allowing both to learn from one another;
- Have a stronger potential influence over the promotion of our common interests; and
- We believe that together we're enriched, as individuals and as organisations.

The memorandum lays the foundation for further discussion and agreement as regards the future liaison between the two organisations. These discussions to include:

- The sharing of information in printed and electronic media;
- Exchanges and assistance with academic research;
- Mutual recognition of conferences and workshops for professional development in Coaching Psychology;
- Discounts for all members for the attendance of conferences; and
- Discounted access to materials published by the Societies.

Specific items:

1. All coaching psychologists who are members of HACP will be offered automatically free Affiliate membership of ISCP, access to the website and the publication *Coaching Psychology International*.
2. HACP can nominate representatives to become ISCP Honorary Vice Presidents.
3. HACP can have a column in *Coaching Psychology International* to promote their activities.
4. HACP can nominate a qualified psychologist to join the Editorial Board of *Coaching Psychology International*.
5. ISCP will recognise all Coaching Psychology conferences and workshops organised by HACP as being suitable for the professional development of its members. Events can be listed on the ISCP website.
6. HACP will encourage and stimulate Coaching Psychology, throughout the whole national territory.
7. The ISCP recognises the accreditation and certification system of the HACP. This means that the accreditation and certification system for coaching psychologists of ISCP and the HACP is equivalent.
